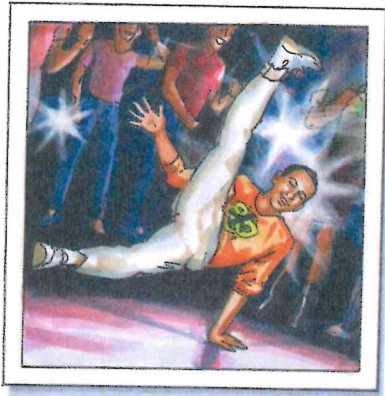


1 Let's read: The good old days

Terry: No, Dad! Please! My friends' dads never come to the club. I'm sure you're a great teacher. But –

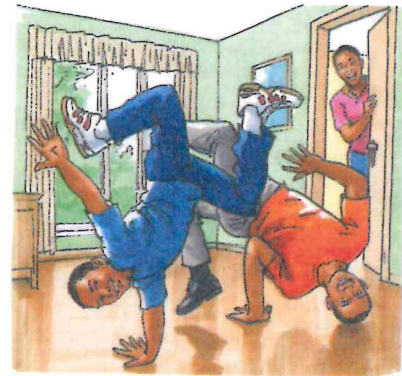
Mr Jackson: But dads are for home, not for school. Right?
